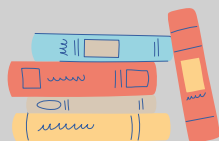

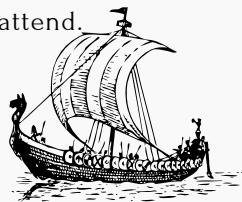
Vikings: Myth, History, and Archaeology (On Zoom)

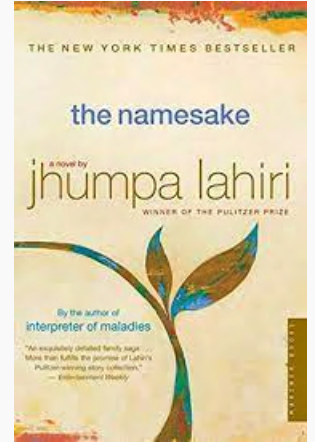

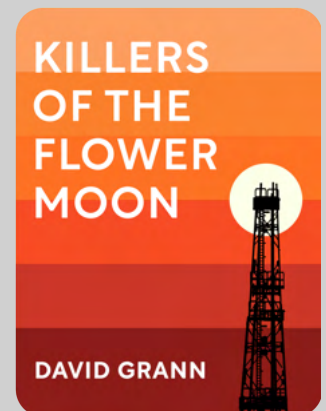
