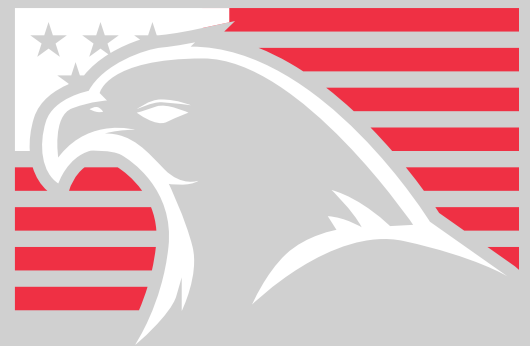
New Moon Paranormal Group

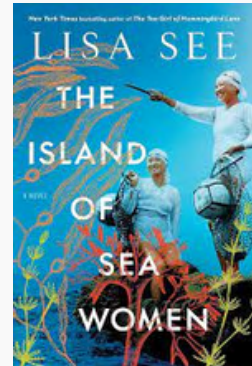

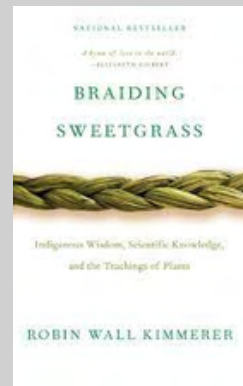
