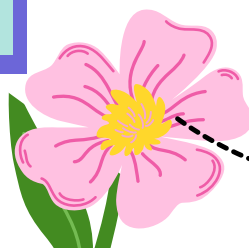

Grab your dancing shoes and get set to move & groove with Miss Jolie!

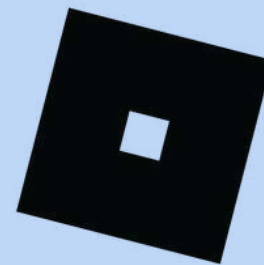
