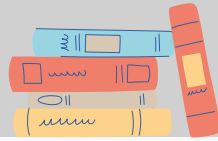

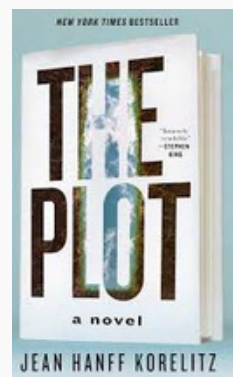

Copies of the book may be picked up at the Reference Desk.

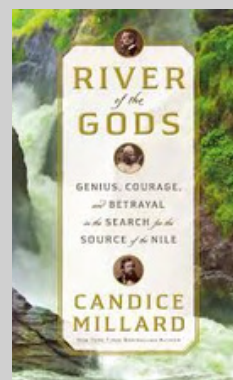


Afternoon Book Club
