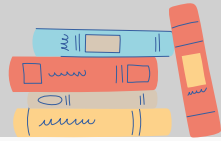

Bunco for Adults

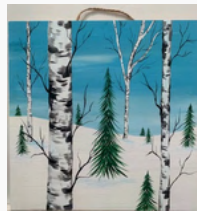

a puzzle exchange! Located on the cart in the vestibule (in front of our display case), patrons can take or leave a puzzle. The puzzle selection is what you make it!

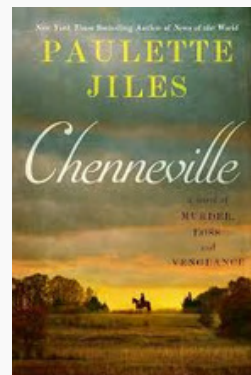

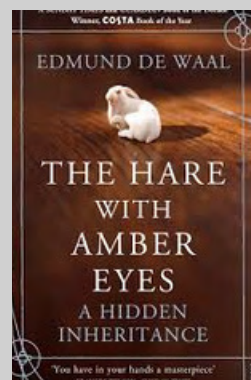
