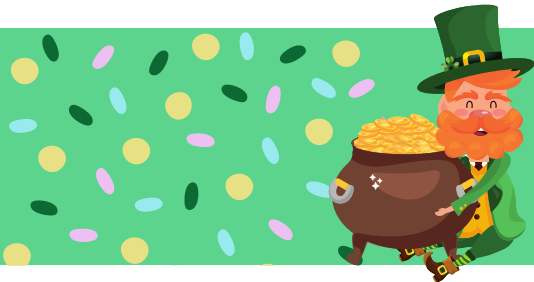

## NJ Maker's Day

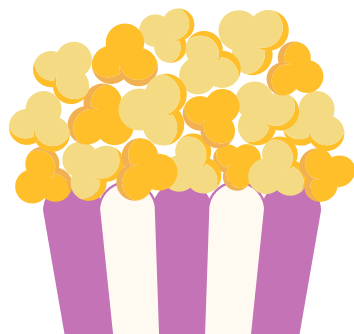
Mar. 22nd from 11-3pm
